LIMITED WARRANTY

IMPLANT CROWNS: For a period of **8 years** from the time of restoration, Monona Dental, S.C. will replace an implant crown or abutment that fails due to breakage at no cost to the patient.*

GOLD CROWNS: For a period of **8 years** from the time of cementation Monona Dental, S.C. will replace a gold restoration that fails due to breakage, misfit or decay at no cost to the patient.*

PORCELAIN VENEERS, CROWNS AND BRIDGES: For a period of **5 years** from the time of cementation, Monona Dental, S.C. will replace or repair a porcelain restoration that fails due to porcelain fracture, misfit or decay at no cost to the patient.*

ROOT CANAL THERAPY: Root canal therapy has a 95% success rate, but occasionally does fail. If your root canal treatment fails, we may send you to an endodontist who specializes in root canals. If this occurs during the first year, Monona Dental, S.C. will refund you 100% of the fee paid for the root canal. After the first year and for a period of **5 years** from the time of treatment, if your root canal fails we will refund the patient portion paid for the root canal treatment.*

COMPOSITE (WHITE) FILLINGS: When a tooth has a cavity, we remove the decayed area and seal the cavity with a composite filling that should no be more that 50% of the tooth. It is the remaining tooth that supports the filling. When a cavity destroys more than 50% of a tooth a crown is needed to hold the tooth together. Sometimes we place a filling thinking the tooth is still strong enough when actually it is not. In this case the tooth begins to break under chewing forces. If this occurs, for a period of **2 years**, we will credit the cost of the filling towards the cost of a crown. In addition, for a period of **2 years** from the date of restoration, we will replace a composite filling due to breakage, misfit or decay at no cost to the patient.*

SEALANTS: For a period of **2 years** after original placement, if necessary, tooth sealant will be replaced or added to at no additional charge.*

***LIMITATIONS:**

1. This warranty will be null and void if the patient does not maintain his/her recommended professional dental cleanings (either every 3, 4 or 6 months).
2. If a tooth becomes sensitive after dental treatment and requires root canal therapy, this does not constitute failure, but is a treatment complication. There are many reasons a tooth requires root canal therapy that are beyond our control (deep cavities, fracture lines and individual patient sensitivities). If the root canal is completed at Monona Dental, S.C. it carries a five year warranty just like the crown.
3. This warranty does not cover breakage due to accident, trauma or inappropriate use (chewing ice, opening bottles, etc.).
